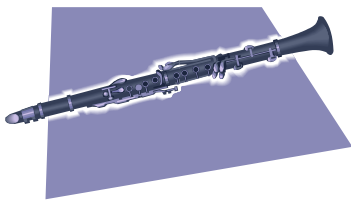


The Rocklin Unified School District is pleased to offer an instrumental music program to 5th and 6th grade students in each of our elementary schools.

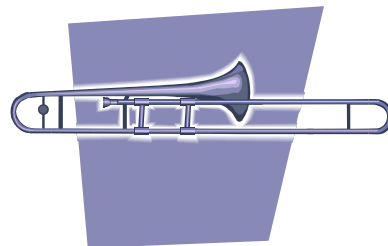
A variety of instrumental music opportunities continue through twelfth grade in the Rocklin Unified School district. We encourage musical experiences for all students.

🎵 EXPECTATIONS 🎵

Each student participating in the Instrumental Music Program is expected to:

- Attend rehearsals and instruction regularly
- Bring his/her instrument and other materials to each rehearsal and instructional lesson
- Participate in performances
- Maintain a consistent practice schedule and show consistent progress on his/her instrument
- Exhibit outstanding behavior
